Cookies are small text files stored on your computer, mobile phone, tablet, or other mobile devices via your browser when you visit our site. They ensure our site runs more efficiently and provide fast, personalized pages suitable for your needs.

Cookies are created when you visit our site. Depending on their duration, we use "session cookies," which are valid until the browser is closed, and "persistent cookies," which remain valid until deleted or until they expire.

Our site uses "first-party cookies" placed directly by the site server, as well as "third-party cookies" placed by other servers to allow third parties outside our site to offer you more suitable services, products, or offers.

Our site utilizes social network plugins. Through these plugins, the relevant social network may access and process your data and combine it with data belonging to your account on that social network. Please review the personal data processing policies of the relevant social networks to get detailed information about their purpose, methods, and duration of processing your personal data.

Cookie Types and Purposes of Use:

Strictly Necessary Cookies: These cookies are mandatory for the correct operation of our site and are used for purposes such as security and authentication. Authentication is used to prevent the loss of current session information. We use these cookies without requiring explicit consent, based on the legal grounds stipulated in Article 5/2 (e) and (f) of the Law on the Protection of Personal Data: "*Data processing is necessary for the establishment, exercise, or protection of any right*" and "*Data processing is necessary for the legitimate interests of the data controller, provided that the fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject are not harmed.*" We indicate which necessary cookies we use in the charts available in Article 5 of our cookie policy.

Functional Cookies: These cookies enable the remembrance of site visitors' preferences such as language, text font size, etc. We require your explicit consent to place functional cookies.

Performance and Analysis Cookies: These cookies help improve our site by collecting information about visitors' site usage, checking whether the site is working properly, and detecting errors. Through these analytical cookies, we obtain information about the use of our website. We require your explicit consent to place analytical cookies.

Targeting and Advertising Cookies: These cookies are used to promote products and services on our site or other domains, to show personalized advertisements to visitors with our business partners, and to measure their effectiveness.

When you visit our website for the first time, we will show you a window containing an explanation about cookies. When you click the "Cookie Policy" button, you can review the categories of cookies and plugins you have selected in the pop-up window, as explained here. When your computer or mobile device reaches the browser, it automatically accepts and predefines cookie data.

DRAAKON ULUSLARARASI TİCARET ANONİM ŞİRKETİ may remove cookies from use on the site, change their types or functions, or add new ones when deemed necessary. Cookie changes will be effective from the update date. If you do not want cookies placed on your device, you can reject, delete, or block the use of cookies. In this case, you may not be able to use some areas properly.

No personal data is transferred abroad directly by the Site. **However, your data collected via Cookies is transferred abroad because 3rd party cookie servers are located abroad.** If you do not want this, you must terminate your visit to the site.

Transfer abroad is carried out via cookies, provided that the relevant person is informed about the possible risks and gives explicit consent to the transfer (Law Article 9/6/a). By approving foreign-sourced cookies, explicit consent is deemed to have been given.

Possible Risks for Transferring Personal Data Abroad via Cookies

Possible risks you may encounter in case your personal data collected via cookies is transferred abroad are stated below:

- **Data Security Risk:** Your personal data received by data recipients abroad may face risks such as unauthorized access, modification, or leakage if adequate security measures are not taken. Such situations may result in the unauthorized use of your personal data by third parties.
- **Different Legal Regulations:** Data protection regulations in the countries where your personal data is transferred may differ from regulations in Turkey. This may cause the protection level of your personal data to vary and increase the risk of your data not being adequately protected.
- **Unauthorized Sharing and Use:** There is a risk that your data may be shared with unauthorized persons by data recipients abroad or used for purposes other than those specified. Such a situation may result in the violation of your personal privacy and misuse of your data.
- **Insufficiency of Technical and Administrative Measures:** If data recipients abroad do not take the necessary technical and administrative measures for the protection of personal data, your data may face security breaches. Such breaches may result in loss, theft of data, or access by unauthorized persons.
- **Response to Data Breaches:** In the event of a data breach occurring abroad, there is a risk that a rapid and effective response to the breach may not be made. This may cause the effects of the data breach to grow and result in wider damage.

Data Subject Rights
